Join us for an international online research workshop series: "Tonewood, Treatments & Tunings for Luthiers", Starting in July 2025. These live, interactive sessions will connect luthiers and tonewood researchers within the musical instrument art and industry. This four-part workshop series will provide a comprehensive understanding of wood as a fundamental material in luthiery. Through online practical exercises, participants will learn to use precise measurement systems and even will learn to manufacture themselves their own measurement simple devices and softwares for characterizing wood sources. Each course must be necessarily completed before the next.

The workshop will be led by Professor Mehran Roohnia, a leading expert in the field. Professor Roohnia has published extensively in prestigious JCR-WoS journals and authored a book chapter in "Wood: Acoustics and Vibration" (Elsevier). He is currently writing a comprehensive book on Properties and Treatment of Tonewood for String Instrument Construction – A Professional Guide for luthiers, commissioned by Springer-Nature. This workshop series will share the knowledge from this book, empowering luthiers to select, tune and utilize the most appropriate wood for each part of their instruments.
